



## **A VIEW of Eli Lilly**

### **Application of the VIEW resource to the Applied GCSE for Science**

Evidence from Eli Lilly was collected to support teachers delivering the Applied GCSE for Science by providing students with access to the working labs at the Erl Wood site.

#### **A summary of the geography of the VIEW of Eli Lilly.**

The VIEW of Eli Lilly provides access to the Erl Wood site in Surrey.

After entering the gates at the front of the site the visitor is outside the reception building and security gate. The visitor must pass through the pedestrian gate to the left of the security guard.

Once the other side of the security gate the visitor can either move left towards the Manor House and Laboratory complex or right towards the Gas Yard and construction area. The majority of the evidence for the virtual visit is covered by moving left towards the Manor House. Moving right will offer access to the Gas Yard and beyond this an area of new construction and two interviews.

At the Manor House the visitor can enter the front entrance and find out about the history of the building and site. Moving on past the main entrance the visitor can enter the far entrance of the House which provides access to several interviews with key employees including the managing director.

Moving on beyond the Manor House to the Laboratory complex offers access to the Link Lobby and then the Lab corridor. In this corridor the visitor can access 15 labs covering both chemistry and biology activity. Each lab includes one or more panoramic images with close up images, some documents, sequences of images and interviews with scientists and technicians.

The visitor can move up and down this corridor to gain access to the labs. The length of the corridor corresponds approximately to the discovery process with Chemistry at the west end moving to Biology at the east end.

The virtual tour operates over more than 30 panoramic navigation points with hundreds of images and several short video sequences. This is accompanied by interviews with 50 employees answering close to 1000 questions !

Most images are accompanied by narratives which is a source of further evidence for the visitor to use. There are also a few web references that users may wish to explore including Eli Lilly's own website.
