

A VIEW of Ford: A Health & Safety Tour

These instructions are intended only as a guide to help locate work based evidence. At each step the user is advised to look around, read any narrative, pickup on timelines and hotspots and listen to any contribution made by the tour guide.

It is to help teachers and others familiarise themselves with part of the virtual workplace and to use in any way in developing classroom based materials. This tour was used as part of a briefing session for Education Business Partnership employees and focuses on A Building only.

Direction / Instruction	Question / Look out for...
Enter Ford through the main gate.	As you move toward the security gate what danger should the pedestrian be aware of?
Enter "A Building". Rotate right to face South.	Find three means of protecting pedestrians.
Rotate left to face East and then move forward.	Look at the blue wall. What should we be alerted to?
Rotate to face South and then move forward. Rotate to face East and then move forward.	What happens in the 'cage' and why is it necessary?
Face East and move forward. Face East and then move forward again.	What colour jacket is the employee wearing and why?

	Which topic on the notice board is in green?
Rotate to face South and move forward.	Facing South, can you see the red stop buttons? What are these for?
	Check out the timeline for the video. Why are machines used to move the heavy underbodies?
Rotate to face East and then move forward.	What danger is found in the large green box?
	What must be activated before entering the cage?
	Check out the tour guide comment.
Face East and move forward. Rotate to face South and move forward.	Can you see the red striped floor? What is it for?
Face East and move forward. Face East and move forward again.	What potential danger does the fork lift truck present?
Face East and move forward. Face East and move forward again. Face East and move forward once again.	What fire equipment is available in this area?

Face South and move forward.	Look into the cage and check out the video. Can you spot any dangers? (Flying around?).
Face South and move forward. Face South and move forward again. Face West and move forward once again.	What protection does the sign tell us to wear?
Face West and move forward, past the cleaning tanks. Face West and move forward. Face West and go up the stairs.	Where mustn't we go?
Face South-West and move up to higher level.	Check out the time line and the video extract. What dangers do you think we will find here?
Face East and move forward. Face North and move forward again.	Explore the sealer deck for three examples of Health and Safety practice.
