

## A VIEW of Ford: Engine sub assembly

These instructions are intended only as a guide to help locate work based evidence. At each step the user is advised to look around, read any narrative, pickup on timelines and hotspots and listen to any contribution made by the tour guide.

<b>Direction / Instruction</b>	<b>Question / Look out for...</b>
Enter Ford through the main gate Stay outside A Building and rotate right to face south-east. Move ahead (south-east) and continue around the edge of the building towards B and C Building. Move ahead (south-east) again. Move ahead (south-east) once again. Move ahead (east) towards B and C Building Move ahead (east) again Move ahead (east) again Move ahead (east) once again past B Building Rotate left to face north east Move ahead (north) around B Building (to the right of the 10mph sign) Move ahead (north) towards C Building Move ahead (north) again Rotate left to face west and click to enter C Building	We are moving around the outside of the building to enter Building C where 'final trim' takes place including engine sub assembly and fitting the engine into the Transit van.
Rotate left to face west Move ahead (west)...  Move ahead (west) watch out for the fork lift truck Move ahead (west)...	...the production line is on your right, you can see a Van moving from right to left.  ...if you look right they are fitting the transit van seats.

You can see the engines waiting to be taken onto the sub assembly production line.</p> <p>... look right and you can see that the engines are suspended and parts added before fitting to the van.</p> <p>...look right and you will see that lots of parts are added to the engine before fitting</p> <p>... Look north east and checkout the timeline for more information</p> <p>...Look east and checkout the moonbuggy</p>
<p>Rotate to face south west...</p>	<p>... Checkout the timeline to see how the engine and the body come together.</p>
